**CALL FOR PAPERS**

Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv invites submissions for participation in the First International Conference "Language Research and Teaching in the Global Economic Environment" to be held on September 19, 2014 at the Faculty of Economics.

Conference co-organizers:

- Department of English for Natural Sciences Departments of the Institute of Philology of Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv
- Department of Foreign Languages for Specific Purposes of Humanities Institute of Kyiv National Aviation University
- Department of Foreign Languages and Technical Translation of the Faculty of Humanities of Lviv State University of Life Safety.

The conference is dedicated to exploring the current and future trends in the teaching of foreign languages in the increasingly globalized economic environment; identifying the mainstreaming trends in teaching and learning foreign languages for specific purposes; discussing innovative approaches to building linguistic competences and academic skills; bringing cutting edge technologies into teaching and learning foreign languages for specific purposes, and various topics of interdisciplinary research. The conference will also address a number of issues that we face with regard to such factors as globalization of education and international standardization of requirements for language education; development of digital media and technologies and their linguistic and didactic potential; and implementation of new approaches to the analysis of various linguistic factors.

We invite papers covering (but not limiting to) the following topics:

1. Teaching foreign languages for specific purposes under globalization of education and academic mobility.
2. Theoretical and methodological problems of linguistic research.
3. Current issues in translation and its teaching under globalization of science and economies.
4. Innovative technologies in research and teaching foreign languages in the global educational environment.
5. Interdisciplinary research in the areas of applied linguistics, ethno-linguistics, sociolinguistics, psycholinguistics, language and culture studies, and philosophy of language.

The conference will include a plenary meeting, section presentations, webinars and workshops. Each presentation in sections will be allocated at least 10 minutes. Working languages: English, Ukrainian and Russian.

The registration fee for participation in the conference amounts to 150 UAH/25 USD/20 EUR. The registration fee includes information package, a publication in the Conference Proceedings (up to 4 full pages), technical support, coffee breaks. The Program and the Conference Proceedings will be distributed among registered participants on the day of the Conference.

**Information for participants:**

The deadline for applications for participation in the conference is May 19, 2014. The application should be sent together with the abstract of your paper in one of the working languages of the conference (100-120 words), the paper (up to 4 full pages) and the confirmation of registration fee payment (scanned receipt). Application, full paper and payment confirmation are to be sent in one e-mail as three attached files. Please indicate the applicant's name in all files (e.g. Smith\_abstract.doc).

Organizing committee will send the confirmation of the participation in the conference and the invitation to the e-mail address indicated in the application by May 30, 2014.

**Guidelines for authors:**

1. The full text of the paper must be sent to the email address of the organizing committee ([conf2014@i.ua](mailto:conf2014@i.ua)) by June 19, 2014 as an attached .rtf or .doc file. The author's name should be indicated in the name of the file (e.g. Smith\_abstract.doc).
2. Papers – up to 4 full pages of A4 format. Standard text – font Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing – 1, indentation – 1.25, margins: 2 cm right, left 3 cm, bottom and top – 2 cm.
3. The Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) is indicated in the upper left corner. In the upper right corner indicates in bold italics – author's name and initials, below in italics – academic degree and title (if applicable), below in italics – job (name of the institution, country). Next line - title of the paper in bold capital letters, justified, size 14.
4. References in the paper should follow the following style: [Petrov 2002, 24]
5. List of References is given at the end of the paper in font size 12, in line, in alphabetical order in accordance with the State standards of Ukraine 7.80, name of the author is indicated in italics.

**Additional publication opportunities:**

Authors will also have an opportunity to publish full articles based on the findings presented at the conference in one of the journals of Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv upon the recommendation of the academic committee of the Conference (provided that the journal guidelines are followed and at the author's expense).
